Questa pandemia ci offre l'opportunità di rinnovare la nostra fiducia in Dio, di proclamare il suo amore e la sua misericordia per tutti i popoli e di partecipare al piano di Dio nel prendere cura dei bisognosi. Non possiamo radunarci nelle nostre chiese, ma possiamo unirci nello spirito e nella preghiera per formare il popolo di Dio, la Chiesa. Dio benedica e protegga te e le tue famiglie. **Message from Fr. Richard:**

As we begin the most solemn week of the liturgical year for which we have prepared during the 40 days of Lent we are reminded of how precarious life can be and that the plans we make for ourselves can be thrown into chaos from one day to the next. As a people of faith, we know that the only constant is the plan of God. God's plan can sometimes be difficult to understand and to accept. It is only by faith and trust in God that we can enter into God's plan. I do not pretend to understand what this terrible pandemic has to do with God's plan even so there are some truths that I hold on to. That God is the God of life not of death and that suffering and death can lead to life and liberation. That God does not abandon us in times of trial. That suffering is not a punishment for sin but can serve to manifest the Gloria of God as we heard in the account of the healing of the man born blind. That we are called to cooperate with God in bringing healing and forgiveness into the world. God often manifests His compassion through our helping each other. This pandemic gives us the opportunity to renew our trust in God, to proclaim his love and mercy for all peoples and to participate in God's plan by caring for others in need. We cannot congregate in our churches but we can join together in spirit and prayer to form God's people, the Church. God bless and protect you and your families. A special prayer goes out to all health care workers and all those who provide us with food, medicine and protection.

**Mensaje del p. Ricardo:**

A medida que comenzamos la semana más solemne del año litúrgico para el que nos hemos preparado durante los 40 días de Cuaresma, recordamos cuán precaria puede ser la vida y que los planes que hacemos para nosotros mismos pueden caer en el caos de un día para otro. Como pueblo de fe, sabemos que la única constante es el plan de Dios. El plan de Dios a veces puede ser difícil de entender y aceptar. Es solo por fe y confianza en Dios que podemos entrar en el plan de Dios. No pretendo entender lo que esta terrible pandemia tiene que ver con el plan de Dios, aun así hay algunas verdades a las que me aferro. Que Dios es el Dios de la vida, no de la muerte, y que el sufrimiento y la muerte pueden conducir a la vida y la liberación. Que Dios no nos abandona en tiempos de prueba. Ese sufrimiento no es un castigo por el pecado, pero puede servir para manifestar la Gloria de Dios tal como lo escuchamos en el relato de la curación del hombre nacido ciego. Que estamos llamados a cooperar con Dios para traer sanidad y perdón al mundo. Dios manifiesta su compasión a través de nuestra ayuda mutua. **Confessions:**

In the situation we find ourselves, it is most appropriate to seek forgiveness from God through prayer. Once the situation changes then go to confession to a priest. If one needs to go to confession during this time then the following is to be observed:

•One can go to confession by appointment if willing to adhere to appropriate procedures

•Confessions will take place in the rectory conference room where there is privacy and the appropriate distance can be kept between the priest and penitent

•Please go to the parish office ring the bell and through the glass door indicate that you would like to confess

•The priest will invite you to go to the back of the rectory and enter through the outer door of the rectory conference room

•On Saturday, April 4 a priest will be available for confessions from 3:00 pm to 4:30 pm

•On Holy Thursday a priest will be available from 4:30 to 6:30

•On Good Friday a priest will be available from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm

•On Holy Saturday a priest will be available from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

•The same procedure will be followed at all times
